Investment Authority. We manage investment accounts on a discretionary basis. Discretionary investment management means that the Advisor makes the ultimate decision to invest in a specific investment.

Account Minimums and Other Requirements. In general, we do not require a minimum household dollar amount to open and maintain advisory accounts.

At this time, Panteles Advisors has chosen to work with the following custodian: Charles Schwab. Panteles Advisors's advisory fees are separate from the fees charged by Charles Schwab. Panteles Advisors's annual advisory fee schedule(s) and details are as follows:

Panteles Advisors's advisory fees, which are negotiated, will not exceed 1.0% of Assets Under Management (AUM), and are based on complexity and guided by the total market value of the assets under advisory. Panteles Advisors does not charge additional fees over and above our agreed to advisory fee. ETFs and Mutual funds have internal fees and expenses, in which Panteles Advisors does not receive or share these fees. Panteles Advisors clients may incur brokerage and other transaction costs by the custodian. Panteles Advisors does not receive these fees nor do we share these fees; see ADV 2A Item 12 for additional information. - **What are your legal obligations to me when acting as my investment adviser? How else does your firm make money and what conflicts of interest do you have?**

Standard of Conduct:

When we act as your investment adviser, we must act in your best interest and not put our interest ahead of you. At the same time, the way we make money creates some conflicts with your interests. You should understand and ask us about these conflicts because they can affect the investment advice we provide you. An example of a conflict is Panteles Advisors receives additional compensation when a client adds money to increase the accounts' value.

- **How might your conflicts of interest affect me, and how will you address them?**

Panteles Advisors investment advisory representatives are compensated based on the amount of client assets (i.e. Cash & Securities) under management in which they service.
