IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

THE FINE SHALL BE DUE FOLLOWING THE SUSPENSION OR PRIOR TO APPLICATION REQUEST. WHILE EMPLOYED BY WELLS FARGO INVESTMENT, LLC, MR. PURINGTON RECEIVED PRIOR VERBAL AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE TRADES FOR CLIENTS IN ORDER TO LIMIT LOSSES AND PROTECT THEIR PRINCIPAL; HE DID NOT HOWEVER HAVE WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION TO DO SO. MR. PURINGTON ACTED ETHICALLY AND MORALLY BY FOLLOWING HIS CUSTOMER'S INSTRUCTIONS TO PROTECT THEIR PRINCIPAL. THE ALLEGED VIOLATION WAS MADE UNKNOWINGLY AND UNINTENTIONALLY BECAUSE THE POLICY IS UNCLEAR. THE CUSTOMERS AUTHORIZED THE TRADES. THERE WERE NO CUSTOMER COMPLAINTS AND NO COMMISSIONS PAID.
