In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

### Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

**Broker Statement**

A longstanding client moved to Maine in late April. Greenwald incorrectly thought that Maine had a de minimus rule. Potomac and Greenwald initiate 4d seven trades in the client's account from April 2023 to July 2023 before registering with the State of Maine in August. The firm was fined \$2500.00 and Greenwald \$500.00 and all commissions (\$765.00) on the trades were restored to the client's account. Potomac and Greenwald signed a consent decree with the State of Maine Office of Securities without admitting or denying that their conduct violated the Maine Uniform Securities Act.
