IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

FLORIDA CLIENT STATED THAT HE WAS DISAPPOINTED IN THE FA'S MANAGEMENT AND THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS FAMILY ACCOUNTS/PORTFOLIOS. THE ACCOUNTS IN ISSUE ARE SIX FEE-BASED, DISCRETIONARY ACCOUNTS MANAGED BY THE FA -- THESE ARE PRIVATE INVESTMENT MANAGEMENT ("PIM") ACCOUNTS. THE CLIENT CLAIMED THAT THE FA PROMISED TO PLACE STOP ORDERS ON ALL SECURITIES IN THE ACCOUNTS SO THAT IN A FALLING MARKET THE SECURITIES WOULD AUTOMATICALLY SELL AND CONVERT TO CASH; FURTHER THAT THE FA DID NOT DO THIS. THE CLIENT CLAIMED THAT THE FA FAILED TO SELL VARIOUS SECURITIES IN THE ACCOUNTS THAT HAD APPRECIATED IN VALUE EVEN THOUGH THE CLIENT HAD INSTRUCTED THE FA TO SELL THE SECURITIES. THE CLIENT DID NOT INDICATE THE SECURITIES IN QUESTION. THE CLIENT HAS REQUESTED THAT ALL MANAGEMENT FEES THAT HAVE BEEN CHARGED TO HIS ACCOUNTS SINCE JANUARY 2007 BE RETURNED TO HIM -- THE FEES AMOUNT TO APPROXIMATELY \$5,933.53. THE CLIENT ALSO REQUESTED THAT THE FA PRESENT HIM WITH A PLAN TO TRY AND RECOUP SOME OF THE DECLINES THAT OCCURRED IN THE VALUE OF HIS ACCOUNTS
