IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement Following a Client's death, I was directed by Client's Beneficiary to liquidate Client's Account and have the proceeds transferred to her existing LPL account, so that she could then transfer 1/5th of the liquid proceeds to each of her 4 siblings. I processed the liquidation of Client's investments and transfer of proceeds to the Beneficiary's LPL account at her request and for her convenience, because she wished to expedite her ability to transfer liquid assets to her siblings. In acting, I was simply trying to fulfill and expedite the Beneficiary's wishes and the Deceased Client's previously expressed wishes. I didn't recognize at the time that she could not authorize the liquidation prior to the account being transformed into a beneficiary account in her name. When I realized this the next day, I called LPL's



compliance to see if this actually was an issue or concern. The compliance person verbally informed me that the transactions had been processed and that he didn't believe there was a concern. About 75 days later, LPL discharged me for this action.

The Beneficiary never questioned what happened and, in fact, specifically thanked me for carrying out her wishes.

Although trying to act in the best interest of and to accommodate the wishes of the Client's Beneficiary, I realize that I acted incorrectly and should have followed the full procedures that exist for the purpose of protecting clients. This has been a painful lesson, but has greatly increased my understanding of and sensitivity to the need to fully follow the established procedures for client accounts.
