IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

**Broker Statement**

THIS WAS A CIVIL SUIT AND THERE WAS NO RESTRICTION OR ANY IMPACT ON ANY LICENSE I HAD. AS A RESULT OF THE JUDGMENT, SHERWOOD & ROBERTS, MY FORMER EMPLOYER, PAID \$20,000. IN 1985, AFTER I HAD BEGUN MY CAREER AT E.F. HUTTON, THE [CUSTOMER'S] ATTORNEY APPROACHED ME FOR PAYMENT. UNTIL THEN, THE [CUSTOMERS] HAD NOT ASKED FOR ANY MONEY. I INTRODUCED THEM TO A BUILDER, THEY MADE A CONTRACT WITH THE BUILDER, LEAVING ME AND MY COMPANY OUT OF THE DEAL. THEY WERE NICE PEOPLE, BUT A YEAR LATER AFTER NOT SPEAKING WITH ME, I FOUND OUT THAT THE BUILDER WAS BROKE. SO I CALLED THE [CUSTOMERS] JUST IN CASE THEY DIDN'T KNOW.
