IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

I ONLY SOLD HALF OF THE POSITION, FEELING THIS WAS THE PRUDENT COURSE OF ACTION. ONLY AFTER THE PUBLICIZED MERGER DID THE CLIENT CALL AND ASK TO CANCEL THE SELL ORDER. THIS CASE WAS SETTLED FOR ECONOMIC REASONS AND THE FACT THAT IT WAS BASICALLY HIS WORD VS. MINE.
