### Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

**Broker Statement** OUR REVIEW FOUND THE CLIENT'S ENTIRE 401K WAS IN COMPANY STOCK. WHEN SHE TRANSFERRED THE STOCK TO AEFA, THE ADVISOR



STRONGLY ADVISED HER TO DIVERSIFY HER PORTFOLIO, BOTH VERBALLY AND IN A WRITTEN FINANCIAL PLAN. INITIALLY, THE CLIENT INDICATED SHE DID NOT WANT TO SELL THE SHARES BECAUSE THEY HAD PERFORMED VERY WELL. WHEN THE PRICE BEGAN TO DECLINE, THE CLIENT STATED SHE WOULD SELL THE SHARES BECAUSE THEY HAD PERFORMED VERY WELL. WHEN THE PRICE BEGAN TO DECLINE, THE CLIENT STATED SHE WOULD SELL THE SHARES ONLY IF THE PRICE PER SHARE RECOVERED. THE CLIENT DID NOT RESPOND TO SUBSEQUENT ADVISOR CALLS OR MAILINGS TO SCHEDULE A FOLLOW-UP CLIENT SERVICE MEETINGS. THE CLIENT EVEN ASKED THE ADVISOR'S ASSISTANT NOT TO CONTACT HER AGAIN. AT NO TIME DID THE CLIENT REQUEST THE SHARES BE SOLD.

RESOLVED AS JUSTIFIED. MY COMMISSION WAS REVERSED AND I PAID THE DEDUCTIBLE UNDER OUR ERROR AND OMISSIONS MARKETING INSURANCE POLICY. WE RESOLVED THE ORIGINAL COMPLAINT (SALES COMPLAINT #37848) AS UNJUSTIFIED IN EARLY 1998. HOWEVER, FURTHER DISCUSSION AND INFORMATION FURNISHED BY THE CLIENT INDICATED THAT ALTHOUGH THE IDS FLEXIBLE ANNUITY CONTRACT WAS NOT UNSUITABLE, THE INVESTMENT PORTFOLIOS WHERE HIS RETIREMENT FUNDS WERE RECOMMENDED AND INVESTED WERE TOO AGGRESSIVE FOR HIS RISK TOLERANCE LEVEL. AFTER A LENGTHLY NEGOTIATION WITH THE CLIENT WE REVERSED THE CONTRACT, RETURNED HIS INVESTED AMOUNT OF \$319,791.38, INTEREST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,702.74 AND AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT TO COVER TAXES ON THE INTEREST AMOUNT RECEIVED.
