IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

The Firm completed its review of this matter and determined that in July of 2015 the customer worked with the representative to set up his account in line with his asset allocation, risk tolerance and time horizon. When the account was set up, the Amazon stock was sold along with other holdings. After the Amazon stock was sold the customer was sent an account statement detailing the transactions. On October 26, 2015 the customer emailed the representative inquiring about the Amazon stock. The representative responded to the email on October 27, 2015 confirming that the Amazon stock had been sold and noted that the funds that were in the customer's account were in alignment with the customer's stated risk tolerance and time horizon. The Firm's records show that the representative emailed the customer again on October 27, 2015 outlining options that could enable the customer to add Amazon stock to the customer's portfolio. The representative explained that the customer could purchase Amazon stock, the customer could purchase mutual funds including Amazon stock or could purchase Exchange Traded Funds (ETF) that had a high allocation of Amazon stock. The representative provided the customer with information about two ETFs that had a high allocation of Amazon stock. The customer did not take any action related to the information he was provided. The customer closed the account on October 11, 2017.
