IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

THE FA STATES HE RECOMMENDED INVESTING IN FUNDS WITH AN ASSET ALLOCATION TOWARDS GROWTH AND INCOME. HE RECOMMENDED FRANKLIN TEMPLETON FUNDS AND GOLDMAN-SACHS FUNDS TO HELP MEET THIS OBJECTIVE. THE FA INDICATES THE PURCHASES WERE AUTHORIZED BY THE CLIENT. OUR RECORDS DO NOT REFLECT THE CLIENT'S DAUGHTERS HAVE TRADING AUTHORIZATION ON THE ACCOUNT; THEY DO NOT NEED TO APPROVE THE TRADES. OUR RECORDS INDICATE THE CLIENT PURCHASED CLASS A FUNDS IN BOTH FRANKLIN TEMPLETON AND GOLDMAN-SACHS FUNDS. THE CLASS A SHARES HAD UPFRONT SALES CHARGES. EXCHANGES WITHIN THE FUND FAMILY COULD HAVE BEEN MADE WITHOUT ADDITIONAL SALES CHARGES. THE CLIENT RECEIVED A \$250,000 BREAKPOINT ON THE FRANKLIN TEMPLETON FUNDS, AND A \$100,000 BREAKPOINT ON THE GOLDMAN-SACHS. OUR RECORDS INDICATE THE CLIENT HAD A DISTRIBUTION IN KIND IN DECEMBER 2007, NO FUNDS WERE SOLD. WHILE WE UNDERSTAND THE DISAPPOINTMENT WITH THE PERFORMANCE OF THE INVESTMENTS, THE PERFORMANCE OF THE FUNDS IS ATTRIBUTED TO CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL AND MARKET FLUCTUATION, WHICH IS A RISK ASSOCIATED WITH INVESTING. IN LIGHT OF THESE CIRCUMSTANCES, THE REQUEST TO BE REIMBURSED FOR THE LOST PRINCIPLE IS RESPECTFULLY DENIED.
