IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement Against my advice, this client asked that I turn on more income than his account could realistically return (approximately 10%). Typically, anything over 4% in revenue can be a short-lived venture. After getting into his principal, I met with him and explained that he was withdrawing too much income and we needed to readjust his income needs. He was still working, yet he wanted this extra income. I did what he asked against my advice because it was his account. He stated that I did excessive trading, which is erroneous because Horter Investment Management charged an annual fee to manage the account, in which no commission would be charged. It does not make a difference if there was excessive trading (which there was not) because he paid an annual fee for the services instead of a commission. The client asked for more income than I was comfortable withdrawing, which caused us to dip into his principal. I made him aware of their situation, and he did not take my advice because he disclosed he needed the extra income.

Allegations: [Customer] alleges that Mr. Sidor provided unsuitable advice regarding the purchase of mutual funds, annuities, and gold and silver. [Customer] also claims that Mr. Sidor misled him regarding the ability to leave assets in a cash account rather than investing the monies in a fund. Further, [Customer] alleges that Mr. Sidor misrepresented his status as a "financial advisor." The events in question occurred from July 2012 - September 2015.
