CLIENT INDICATES THE FA CLAIMED HE HAD A BETTER IDEA, BUT THAT HAS RESULTED IN A TAX INCREASE. CLIENT STATES SHE NOW IS PAYING QUARTERLY PAYMENTS TO THE IRS AND HER TAX PREPARER HAS INFORMED HER THE CAPITAL GAINS (ASSOCIATED WITH THE MUTUAL FUND) WILL HAPPEN EVERY YEAR. CLIENT IS ASKING THE FA HOW WE CAN MAKE THIS GO BACK TO WHAT SHE WANTED.

FA HAS INDICATED DURING A TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH THE CLIENT IN JULY OF 2007, SHE INFORMED HIM SHE NO LONGER DESIRED TO RECEIVE INCOME FROM THE HARTFORD ANNUITY; HOWEVER, SHE WOULD START TO TAKE INCOME AGAIN AT RETIREMENT. FA BELIEVED A MUTUAL FUND WOULD BE MORE APPROPRIATE FOR THE CLIENT'S FUTURE INCOME NEEDS AND HE DISCUSSED THE DETAILS OF LIQUIDATING THE HARTFORD ANNUITY AND PURCHASING THE LORD ABBETT AFFILIATED FUND. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE FA SPOKE WITH YOU AGAIN IN AUGUST 2007 ABOUT HIS RECOMMENDATION AND YOUR SON-IN-LAW WAS PRESENT DURING THIS TELEPHONE DISCUSSION. FA STATED CLIENT ULTIMATELY AGREED WITH HIS RECOMMENDATION AND CLIENT SIGNED THE FORM TO LIQUIDATE THE ANNUITY. FA HAS INDICATED HE DID SPEAK WITH THE CLIENT IN APRIL 2008 TO DISCUSS THE TAX IMPLICATIONS FROM THE 2007 YEAR-END MUTUAL FUND DISTRIBUTIONS AND FA MET WITH CLIENT IN HER HOME ON MAY 19, 2008 TO PROVIDE FURTHER CLARIFICATION ON HOW A MUTUAL FUND OPERATES. FA BELIEVED CLIENT WAS SATISFIED AFTER THIS MEETING AND CLIENT DID NOT REQUEST ANY CHANGES TO BE MADE TO HER PORTFOLIO. UNFORTUNATELY, SINCE THAT TIME, WE HAVE EXPERIENCED TUMULTUOUS MARKET CONDITIONS WHICH HAVE HAD A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON ACCOUNT VALUATIONS. BASED ON OUR REVIEW OF THIS MATTER, WE WILL NOT BE MAKING ANY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE CLIENT'S ACCOUNT.

THE CUSTOMER CLAIMS THE IR SOLD HER A MEDIUM TERM CORPORATE NOTE AND INDICATED SHE COULD SELL THE INVESTMENT AT ANYTIME AND RECEIVE HER ENTIRE AMOUNT INVESTED BACK. THE CUSTOMER THEN CLAIMS SHE LATER CONTACTED THE IR AND INDICATED SHE WANTED TO SELL THE MEDIUM TERM NOTE AND A TREASURY INVESTMENT. SHE CLAIMS THAT IS THE FIRST TIME THE IR ADVISED HER SHE MIGHT NOT GET ALL HER MONEY BACK. SHE INDICATES SHE LEFT A MESSAGE THE NEXT MORNING TELLING THE IR TO HOLD OFF ON THE SALES BUT THEN WAS INFORMED HE HAD SOLD THOSE TWO INVESTMENTS PLUS A STOCK HOLDING. CLAIMS SHE NEVER AUTHORIZED THE SALE OF THE STOCK HOLDING. INDICATES THE TRADES COST HER APPROXIMATELY \$9,500.00 AND SEEMS UPSET SHE CAN ONLY DEDUCT \$3,000.00 OF LOSSES PER YEAR.
