What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

Despite the fact this matter was settled, I deny all claims as they are not accurate, and no liability or act of wrongdoing should be construed against me whatsoever. I have not been the broker of record for the client since January 2015. I also have not been the portfolio manager since that time either. I never promoted or recommended she open or use a line of credit. Furthermore, we discussed diversification many times, but the fear of paying taxes and the need for income resulted in the client not following or taking my recommendations. Another very important fact at issue was the client withdrew large sums of money while her account was with UBS, which accounts for some of the claimed losses. This matter was settled to avoid the cost and uncertainties of the arbitration forum and I was not asked to contribute any monies toward the settlement of this matter. In addition, I intend to seek the removal of this complaint from my professional record by all means afforded to me.

CLAIMANTS FURTHER ALLEGE THEY WERE NOT ADVISED OF UNDERLYING CHANGES IN THE OPTIONS STRATEGY AND THE ASSOCIATED RISKS OF THOSE CHANGES. MR. BURNS AND DBSI DENY THE ALLEGATIONS OF WRONGDOING.
