HE APPROACHED ME ABOUT TRADING OPTIONS THROUGH ME. AT THAT TIME MY IMPRESSION WAS THAT BRANCH MANAGEMENT WAS AWARE OF THE ACTIVITY AND THAT IT DID NOT VIOLATE ANY REGULATIONS. I NOW KNOW DIFFERENTLY. THE NYSE HAS ALSO CENSURED THE BRANCH MANAGER FOR FAILURE TO SUPERVISE THESE

ACTIVITIES. THIS EMPLOYEES TRADING IN MY ACCOUNT RESULTED IN A UNREIMBURSED FINANCIAL LOSS TO ME OF APPROXIMATELY \$25,000.
