IN REGARDS TO THE ESTATE FOR [CUSTOMERS], THE SUCCESSOR EXECUTOR FOR [CUSTOMER'S] ESTATE HAS QUESTIONED THE SUITABILITY OF THE COUPLE'S INVESTMENT ALLOCATION DURING THE ECONOMIC AND INVESTMENT MARKET DECLINE IN 2008/2009. FOR THE PERIOD OF EIGHT YEARS, THE ADVISOR SERVICED THE [CUSTOMERS'] AND DISPUTES THE ALLEGATIONS. THE [CUSTOMERS'] EXECUTED INVESTMENT AGREEMENTS CONFIRMS THEIR RISK PROFILE, AND WAS ALSO SUBSEQUENTLY EXECUTED BY THEIR POWER OF ATTORNEY. COUPLED WITH THIS CLEAR UNDERSTANDING OF THEIR RISK PROFILE, WAS REGULAR ONGOING PORTFOLIO REPORTING INCLUDING ASSET VALUE AND THE ASSET TYPE ALLOCATIONS, THAT WERE DISTRIBUTED TO BOTH THE CLIENT COUPLE, AND THEIR POWER OF ATTORNEY.
