IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

BASED ON THE CLIENTS LITIGIOUS PAST WITH HIS FORMER REPRESENTATIVE AND AFTER COMPLETING A FULL FINANCIAL REVIEW IT WAS DETERMINED THAT THE MONEY BEING INVESTED IN THE JACKSON NATIONAL PERSPECTIVE L ANNUITY WOULD INITIALLY BE PLACED IN THE MONEY MARKET FUND. THE PERSPECTIVE L WAS CHOSEN OVER THE PERSPECTIVE II BECAUSE THE CLIENT WANTED A SHORTER SURRENDER PERIOD THAN WHAT WAS OFFERED THROUGH THE PERSPECTIVE II AT A LOWER COST. THE MONEY MARKET WAS CHOSEN OVER THE FIXED INCOME PORTFOLIO BECAUSE THE ANNUITY COMPANY RESERVED THE RIGHT TO RESTRICT REDEMPTIONS OUT OF THE FIXED PORTFOLIO FOR UP TO TWO YEARS. BECAUSE THE CLIENT AND MYSELF BOTH FELT THAT AN INTEREST RATE HIKE WAS A POSSIBILITY IN THE NEAR FUTURE, AND THE FIXED OPTION WAS ONLY PAYING 1%, IT WAS MORE IMPORTANT TO HAVE THE FLEXIBILITY TO REALLOCATE FUNDS TO AN EQUITY PORTFOLIO SHOULD AN INTEREST RATE HIKE TRIGGER A CORRECTION IN THE EQUITIES MARKET. BASED ON THE CLIENTS PAST EXPERIENCES IN THE EQUITIES MARKETS WHICH INCLUDED SIGNIFICANT LOSSES IN THE DOTCOM BUBBLE OF 2001 & 2002, THE CLIENT RELAYED TO ME THAT HE WAS STILL COMFORTABLE WITH THIS DECISION AS RECENTLY AS HIS LAST REVIEW IN THE SPRING OF 2014. AFTER A CONSIDERABLE PERIOD OF BEING HESITANT TO ALLOCATE MONEY TO AN EQUITY SUB-ACCOUNT, I BELIEVE THE CLIENT IS NOW SECOND GUESSING HIS DECISION.
