IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement IN 1987, I WAS CHARGED WITH A "FALSE REPORT OF A CRIME" THAT WAS SUBSEQUENTLY DISMISSED. MY ATTY AND I DID NOT UNDERSTAND HOW THIS CHARGE COULD HAVE MATERIALIZED. THE CHARGE DID NOT MAKE SENSE. ALTHOUGH I DO NOT REMEMBER ALL THE DETAILS, THE FOLLWING IS PROVIDED AS A BASIC OVERVIEW:

WHILE A STUDENT AT THE UNIV OF CA, LA (UCLA), I PARKED MY CAR IN A PERMITTED UNIV PARKING LOT. DURING THE 1996 HOLIDAY SEASON, I DID NOT USE MY CAR FOR AN EXTENDED PERIOD OF TIME SINCE I LIVED ACROSS FROM THE CAMPUS. ONE DAY, I WENT TO DRIVE MY CAR AND



COULD NOT FIND IT IN THE PARKING LOT. SINCE MY CAR WAS OPEN AND DID NOT HAVE A TOP (SIMILAR TO A CONVERTIBLE), I FIGURED THAT SOMEONE HAD STOLEN MY PARKING PERMIT AND THE CAR HAD BEEN TOWED. I WENT TO THE CAMPUS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICE AND ASKED IF MY CAR WAS TOWED. I WAS TOLD THAT IT WAS NOT TOWED. I MADE A THEFT REPORT. MY CAR WAS A 1975 CHEVY BLAZER, 10 YRS OLD, THAT WAS WORTH \$2-3000. AS IT TURNED OUT, THE CAR WAS TOWED BY THE CAMPUS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICE BECAUSE NO PARKING PERMIT WAS DISPLAYED ON THE CAR. HOWEVER, THEIR COMPUTER SYSTEM DID NOT SHOW THIS INFO; WE LEARNED LATER, TOWED CAR INFO OVER 30 DAYS OLD WAS DELETED FROM THEIR COMPUTER SYSTEM. IN ADDITION, I WAS NEVER INFORMED BY THE CAMPUS LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICE OR THE TOWING COMPANY ABOUT THE STATUS OF MY CAR BEFORE COMPLETING A THEFT REPORT. SOON AFTER I COMPLETED A THEFT REPORT, I WAS CHARGED FOR MAKING A "FALSE REPORT OF CRIME". HOWEVER, THIS DIDN'T MAKE SENSE, WHY WOULD I MAKE A FALSE THEFT REPORT WHEN MY CAR WAS IN A TOWING YARD? IN ADDITION, MY CAR WASN'T WORTH VERY MUCH; I COULD NEVER REPLACE IT WITH THE PROCEEDS OF AN INSURANCE CLAIM. WHEN THE CASE REACHED THE TRIAL COURT, IT WAS DISMISSED.THE LA MUNICIPAL CRT TOLD ME THE CASE DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN DESTROYED FOR THAT PERIOD. ATTACHED IS ORIGINAL CASE DOCUMENT PREPARED BY LA MUNICIPAL CRT (310-727-6020). AS PER THIS CASE DOUCMENT, CASE RECORDS HAVE BEEN DESTROYED.
