- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

FURTHER THE CLIENT CLAIMS THAT THE FA DID NOT KEEP HIM APPRISED AS TO THE FINANCIAL DIFFICULTY THAT WORLDCOM WAS EXPERIENCING IN 2002, NOR THAT THE CREDIT RATING FOR THE BOND HAD BEEN LOWERED.
