What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

CLAIMANT, A DOCTOR WITH A SUBSTANTIAL NET WORTH AND MANY YEARS OF INVESTMENT EXPERIENCE, COMMENCED AN ARBITRATION PROCEEDING ASSERTING CLAIMS OF UNSUITABILITY AND SOUGHT DAMAGES FOR ALLEGED LOSSES OF \$1.9 MILLION IN HIS ACCOUNT INCURRED DURING THE BEAR MARKET. IN ACTUAL FACT, THE CLAIMANT HAD DEALT WITH ME FOR OVER SEVEN YEARS BEFORE THE ONSET OF THE BEAR MARKET, HAD EARNED SUBSTANTIAL PROFITS THROUGH THESE DEALINGS, AND HAD NEVER COMPLAINED ABOUT THE QUALITY OF SERVICES OR THE FREQUENCY OF OUR COMMUNICATIONS. WHEN THE BEAR MARKET STRUCK, CLAIMANT SAW SOME OF HIS SIGNIFICANT PROFITS DECLINE, AND WOUND UP TRANSFERRING TO ANOTHER BROKER/DEALER WITHOUT COMPLAINT. LONG AFTERWARDS, CLAIMANT COMMENCED THIS PROCEEDING. I REJECTED THESE CLAIMS IN THEIR ENTIRETY ON THE GROUNDS THAT 1) CLAIMANT INCURRED NO LOSS BUT RATHER MADE A SUBSTANTIAL NET PROFIT OF OVER \$1.1 MILLION WHILE THE ACCOUNT WAS MANAGED BY ME DESPITE THE BEAR MARKET, AND 2) THE CLAIMANT AND I HAD MULTIPLE, DOCUMENTED FACE-TO-FACE MEETINGS AND TELEPHONE DISCUSSIONS DURING WHICH WE REVIEWED IN DETAIL THE ACCOUNT, THE INVESTMENTS IN THE ACCOUNT, AS WELL AS THE INVESTMENT GOALS OF THE CLAIMANT. DURING THE TIME PERIOD AT ISSUE, DESPITE OUR NUMEROUS MEETINGS AND CONTACTS CLAIMANT NEVER ONCE COMPLAINED HOW THE ACCOUNT WAS BEING MANAGED. ULTIMATELY, CLAIMANT DISMISSED ALL OF THE CLAIMS ASSERTED AGAINST ME AND MY COMPANY, VAHANIAN & ASSOCIATES FINANCIAL PLANNING INC. ON THE EVE OF THE HEARING, A SETTLEMENT OF \$28,000 WAS ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE BROKER-DEALER AND THE CLAIMANT WHICH WAS SIGNIFICANTLY LESS THAN THE ANTICIPATED LEGAL FEES. I DID NOT CONTRIBUTE ONE PENNY TO THIS SETTLEMENT.
