IAPD Information About Representatives

What is included in a IAPD report?

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

IN HIS CAPACITY AS THE EXECUTIVE VICE PRESIDENT OF CENTRAL BANK, EDWARD THOMAS KRATTY (JR) RECEIVED A PHONE CALL (IN 1976) FROM A CUSTOMER IN LAS VEGAS STATING THAT HE WAS OUT THERE GAMBLING, AND DID NOT WISH HIS WIFE TO KNOW. HE ASKED THAT MR. KRATTY APPROVE HIS CREDIT UNDER ANOTHER NAME, AND ASSURED MR. KRATTY THAT EVERYTHING WOULD BE O.K. AND THAT HE WOULD TAKE CARE OF ANY OBLIGATIONS. THIS CUSTOMER CARRIED BALANCES IN EXCESS OF A LOW SIX-FIGURE. WHEN CONTACTED BY A HOTEL FOR A LINE OF CREDIT REGARDING THIS CUSTOMER, MR. KRATTY O.K.'D THE CUSTOMER'S CREDIT UNDER ANOTHER NAME. SEVERAL MONTHS LATER, MR. KRATTY WAS CONTACTED BY THE HOTEL WHICH STATED THAT THEY WERE LOOKING FOR THE CUSTOMER, AND THAT HE OWED THE HOTEL \$5,00.00. MR. KRATTY CONTACTED THE CUSTOMER, AT WHICH TIME THE CUSTOMER STATED THAT HE WOULD TAKE CARE OF ALL MATTERS. IN 1977, MR. KRATTY WAS CONTACTED BY THE F.B.I. WHICH REQUESTED INFORMATION ABOUT THE ABOVE REFERENCED INCIDENT. IN 4/79, MR. KRATTY WAS CHARGED WITH



HELPING THE ABOVE CUSTOMER. IN 6/79, MR. KRATTY WAS FOUND NOT GUILTY. THE ABOVE CASE WAS HEARD IN THE U.S. DISTRICT COURT FOR THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF MISSOURI, WESTERN DIVISION (DOCKET #79-00040-02-CR-W-4).
