## **IAPD Information About Representatives**

MOTIVATED BY THE COST OF LITIGATION, THE FIRM AND I, JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY, ENTERED INTO A CONSENT AGREEMENT (THE MINIMUM REPORTABLE AMOUNT) TO BRING CLOSURE TO THIS MATTER. THIS COMPLAINT HAD NOTHING TO DO WITH MY PERSONAL SALES PRACTICES.
