### Customer Dispute

This section provides information regarding a customer dispute that was reported to the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) by the Investment Adviser Representative (IAR), an investment adviser and/or securities firm, and/or a securities regulator. The event may include a consumer-initiated, investment-related complaint, arbitration proceeding or civil suit that contains allegations of sales practice violations against the individual.

The customer dispute may be pending or may have resulted in a civil judgment, arbitration award, monetary settlement, closure without action, withdrawal, dismissal, denial, or other outcome.

**Reporting Source:** Individual

**Employing firm when activities occurred which led to the complaint:** Legend Equities Corporation

**Allegations:** Client filed a complaint with the annuity company dated June 30, 2017 alleging that he was told by his former advisor that the IncomeLOCK +6 Living Benefit Option on his Fixed and Variable Annuity contract offered a spousal continuation option. When the client discovered that spousal continuation was not available, he inquired with the annuity company if he could rollover his contracts to another annuity that offered a spousal continuation option with a reduction on the surrender fees that would be incurred. The annuity company responded advising him that option was not available. After the request was denied, the client decided to rollover the contracts to a new contract with another firm. The annuity company's review concluded the proper disclosures were provided to enable the client to make an informed decision. The request to refund a courteous portion of the account fees or surrender fees that were incurred by rolling the contracts over to a new annuity contract was denied. The annuity company forwarded a copy of the complaint to Lincoln Investment on September 5, 2017 after receiving an appeal from the client. Through our conversations with the client's former advisor, who has stated that he met with the client on January 30th, 2015 to discuss his retirement income options because of his early retirement at the age of 56. The IncomeLOCK Single Income option benefit was specifically chosen to maximize his benefits and to minimize the management fees. Another reason for that decision was based on the fact that the client's spouse was 10 years older. The former advisor also confirmed that the client was never told verbally or in writing that the Income Lock benefit offered a spousal continuation option. To the contrary, the IncomeLOCK +6 Living Benefit Option Selection and Disclosure form which was signed and dated by the client on February 11, 2015 selecting the single custom allocation option states: The benefit will terminate automatically if: " Upon your



death (if a single benefit option is chosen) or upon the death of both you and your spousal beneficiary (if a joint benefit is selected)" Based on our review and findings the request for 50% of the surrender fees incurred when the client decided to proceed with the rollover to another firm was denied.
