- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Broker Statement	THIS ALLEGATION IS ERRONEOUS.THE CLIENT INITIATED THE PURCHASE AT THE ADVICE AND COUNSEL OF HER GOOD FRIEND, WHO SHE SAID WAS A VERY SUCCESSFUL HEDGE FUND MANAGER. HER FRIEND STRONGLY ADVOCATED THAT THE CLIENT HAVE A PORTION OF HER ASSETS IN ASIAN CURRENCIES. THE CLIENT ASKED ME TO FIND A VEHICLE THAT HAD ASIAN CURRENCY EXPOSURE. WE SETTLED ON THE UBS "PRINCIPLE PROTECTED" NOTE ISSUED BY LEHMAN BROTHERS.
