IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

Before the client decided to participate in the strategy at issue, I informed the client about the mechanics of the strategy as well as the potential risks and rewards involved. I continuously updated the client on the strategy on a monthly basis, including meetings and calls with the strategy team. Unfortunately, after the strategy suffered losses during a month of almost unprecedented market gyrations, the customer retained a contingency fee attorney who sued UBS (not me). UBS requested an arbitration Award dismissing the Statement of Claim in its entirety. The Panel granted UBS' request and denied the claims because it was shown - with clear and convincing evidence - that I was correct in considering this a suitable investment for the customer, and that the investment's potential risks and rewards were carefully and robustly explained to the customer by me, by the trading team, and in writing, before her investment, again when she raised questions about its performance, and again when she decided to reduce her position but maintain a balance for a period of time. While I was not a named Respondent, I testified frankly over three days, answering all questions posed by the customer's attorney, the UBS attorney and the arbitrators. As noted above, after hearing my testimony the arbitrators dismissed the claims.
