What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

CLIENT STATES THEY CONTACTED IR TO CHANGE THEIR INVESTMENTS AROUND. CLIENT INDICATES DURING THE CONVERSATION, IR PROVIDED NO OPTIONS, BUT INSTEAD INFORMED THEM HE HAD JUST THE RIGHT THING FOR THEM AND HE WOULD TAKE CARE OF THE NECESSARY PAPERWORK. CLIENTS STATE THEY WERE WITHDRAWING \$16,000 FROM THE IRA FOR A FARM PAYMENT, REALIZING THEY WOULD HAVE TO PAY TAXES ON THIS AMOUNT AND THAT THE REMAINING FUNDS WERE BEING PLACED IN MUNICIPAL BONDS. CLIENT INDICATES THEY WERE LOOKING FOR AN INVESTMENT THAT WOULD NOT CONTINUE TO DECLINE. RECENTLY, THE CLIENTS MET WITH THEIR TAX PREPARER AND CLAIM THEY NOW HAVE REALIZED THE FULL AMOUNT OF THE IRA WAS DISTRIBUTED AND THEY OWE OVER \$12,000 IN ADDITIONAL TAXES. CLIENTS STATES THERE MUST BE A MISTAKE AND BELIEVE THAT THEY WERE MISLED. CLIENTS WOULD LIKE REIMBURSEMENT OF TAXES OR THE TRANSACTIONS REVERSED. LOSSES EXCEED \$5,000.

ACCORDING TO IR, THE CLIENTS APPROACHED HIM AND INDICATED THEY WANTED TO PURCHASE MUNICIPAL BONDS ON THE ADVICE OF THEIR CPA. IR FURTHER STATED HE RECOMMENDED THE CLIENTS CONTINUE TO HOLD THEIR NORMAL FUNDS OR TO EXCHANGE THE MUTUAL FUNDS FOR A MUNICIPAL BOND FUND WITHIN THE IRA. IR ALSO INDICATED HE EXPLAINED THAT ONLY TAXABLE BONDS COULD BE PURCHASED IN THE IRA ACCOUNT. THE IR ALSO INDICATED THAT THE CLIENT DECIDED TO SELL THE MUTUAL FUNDS AND BUY MUNICIPAL BONDS. IR INDICATED HE INFORMED THE CLIENTS THAT LIQUIDATING THE MUTUAL FUNDS IN THE IRA ACCOUNT WOULD CREATE A TAXABLE EVENT. FURTHERMORE, IR STATED HE REMINDED CLIENTS IN APRIL 2002 TO WITHHOLD A PORTION OF THE DISTRIBUTION FOR TAXES SINCE THE CLIENTS OPTED TO TAKE THE FULL DISTRIBUTION WITHOUT WITHHOLDING TAXES. BASED ON OUR REVIEW, IT APPEARS THE IR FOLLOWED THE CLIENTS' INSTRUCTIONS. CLAIM DENIED.
