Broker Statement THE INVESTMENT STRATEGY I PRESENT TO THE CLIENT WAS THE SAME THAT I SHARED WITH MANY OTHER CLIENTS WITH SIMILAR INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES: BUYING LONG TERM US TREASURY STRIPS AT A BIG DISCOUNT AT THE TOP OF THE CURRENT RATE CYCLE AND HOLDING THEM UNTIL LONG TERM RATES WERE SUBSTANTIALLY LOWER GAVE HIM THE OPPORTUNITY FOR THE ABOVE AVERAGE TOTAL RETURNS USING A CONSERVATIVE INVESTMENT. THE UNKNOWN WAS HOW LONG IT WOULD TAKE FOR THE CURRENT RATES TO FALL TO COMPLETE ITS CYCLE, BUT ESTIMATED TO BE AROUND A YEAR OR TWO BEFORE WE WOULD LOOK AT



SELLING. THE VERY WORST HE COULD EXPECT WAS TO JUST HOLD THE BONDS TO MATURITY AND GET HIS TOTAL INVESTMENT BACK AT AN ATTRACTIVE ANNUAL YIELD. ALL CLIENTS, INCLUDING THE CLAIMANT, WERE INFORMED THAT THE STRIP BONDS FLUCTUATED IN MARKET VALUE JUST LIKE OTHER INVESTMENTS AND THAT THE ABOVE AVERAGE YIELD WOULD OCCUR WHEN THE RATE DECLINE COMPLETED ITS CYCLE. AT NO TIME DID THE CLIENT CALL ME AND INSTRUCT ME TO REVERSE THE TRANSACTION AND AT NO TIME DID I INFORM HIM OR ANY OTHER CLIENTS TO EXPECT \$100 OF PROFIT PER \$1,000 INVESTED.
