FA FURTHER STATED THROUGH EMAILS CLIENT VERIFIED THE COST OF TRANSFERRING OUT OF JONES BUT NO TRANSFER INSTRUCTIONS WERE PROVIDED. BASED ON OUR REVIEW, WE RESPECTFULLY DENY REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT. ACCOUNT RECORDS SHOW ALL ASSETS WERE SOLD, A CHECK WAS ISSUED AND THE ACCOUNT WAS CLOSED IN MARCH.
