IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

IN A LETTER DATED 1/11/06 FROM WELLS FARGO TO THE CLIENT, WELLS FARGO REFERENCED VARIOUS DOCUMENTS WHERE THE CLIENT HAD INFORMATION WHICH DIRECTLY OPPOSED HIS COMPLAINT WITH REGARDS TO HIS RISK TOLERANCE AND INVESTMENT EXPERIENCE. WELLS FARGO TOLD THE CLIENT "WE REGRET THAT YOU FEEL THE INVESTMENTS WERE UNSUITABLE. BASED ON THE ABOVE FACTS, WE DO NOT BELIEVE THAT WFI HAS ANY OBLIGATION TO REIMBURSE YOU FOR ANY PRINCIPAL LOSSES YOU MAY HAVE INCURRED IN THE ACCOUNT. HOWEVER, AS WE VALUE YOUR BUSINESS, WFI WOULD LIKE TO OFFER A ONE TIME CLIENT ACCOMMODATION OF \$11,448.35. THIS REPRESENTS THE COMMISSIONS CHARGED IN YOUR ACCOUNT FROM INCEPTION." I SPOKE WITH THE AUTHOR OF THIS LETTER WHO TOLD ME WFI ONLY REIMBURSED THE CLIENT WITH THE COMMISSIONS PAID IN ORDER TO RETAIN HIM AS A CLIENT, NOT DUE TO ANY WRONGDOING ON THE PART OF ANYONE AT WFI. IN REALITY THE MONEY PAID WAS NOT A SETTLEMENT, BUT A GOOD FAITH OFFER TO THE CLIENT TO STAY WITH WFI.
