What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

IN 12/79, FITZPATRICK SOLD A CONTRACT TO A CLIENT OF ANOTHER BROKER WHO WAS ON VACATION. THE BROKER HAD SOLD THE WRONG CONTRACT WITHOUT PATRICK'S KNOWLEDGE AND THE FIRM WILL BE AT A CFTC HEARING. FITZPATRICK IS NOT INVOLVED WITH THE INVESTIGATION. *** RECEIVED COPY OF COMMODITY FUTURES LAW REPORTS, WHICH INDICATES THE FOLLOWING REPARATIONS COMPLAINT: COMMODITY FUTURES TRADING COMMISSION; NO. R81-1328-82-432. OCTOBER 31, 1985. THE COMPLAINT WAS BROUGHT ABOUT BY [CUSTOMER], AGAINST THOMSON MCKINNON SECURITIES, INC.,



[BROKER], AND JOHN D. FITZPATRICK. IT WAS FILED SEPTEMBER 8, 1981. THE COMPLAINT ORIGINALLY CONSISTED OF FIVE COUNTS BUT HAS SINCE BEEN REDUCED TO TWO. COUNTS TWO AND THREE WHICH ALLEGE UNAUTHORIZED HANDLING OF A GOLD SALE AND SILVER TRADE RESPECTIVELY, HAVE BEEN SUBSUMED IN COUNT ONE WHICH ALLEGES THE UNAUTHORIZED HANDLING OF A DECEMBER 1979 SILVER TRADE BY RESPONDENTS. COUNT FOUR CHARGES RESPONDENTS WITH FAILURE TO PROVIDE [CUSTOMER] WITH NEGOTIABLE RECEIPTS FOR THREE GOLD BARS OWNED BY [CUSTOMER] FROM 1973 UNTIL MARCH 1980. FINALLY, COUNT FIVE ALLEGING MISAPPROPRIATION OF 3.550 OUNCES OF GOLD WAS WITHDRAWN PRIOR TO HEARING. DISCUSSION AND CONCLUSION: "BY SUGGESTING A JANUARY DELIVERY WITHOUT ALSO ADVISING THAT THE JANUARY CONTRACT WAS DOUBLE IN SIZE TO THE DISCUSSED SILVER BAG STORAGE HOLDING, [BROKER] MISLED HIS CLIENT. AS AN ASSOCIATED PERSON WHO WAS ALSO GIVING TRADING ADVICE, [BROKER] IS EXPECTED TO KNOW THE DIFFERENT SIZES OF CONTRACTS ON THE DIFFERENT EXCHANGES AND THE VARYING DELIVERY CYCLES...[BROKER] DOES NOT DENY THAT HE POSSESSED THIS KNOWLEDGE. THEREFORE HIS FAILURE TO PROVIDE COMPLAINANT WITH THIS INFORMATION CAUSED COMPLAINANT TO TAKE ACTION CONTRARY TO THE DESIRED INTENT. THIS CONSTI*SEE FAQ #1*
