PRESENTLY ALL HAVE PROFITED FROM THE CHANGES TO THE ENDEAVOR AND LIFE OF VA ANNUITIES. I WOULD USE THE SAME STRATEGY AGAIN IF SIMILAR SITUATIONS SURFACED. THE CHANGES WERE MADE DUE TO THE LACK OF PERFORMANCE OF THE FRANKLIN PRODUCT AND THE DOWNGRADING OF S&P OF THE VENTURE TO BBB. IN THIS CASE, [CUSTOMER] SIGNED EVERY DOCUMENT AND MORE TO TRANSFER HER ASSETS FROM ONE ANNUITY TO ANOTHER. SHE WAS MADE FULLY AWARE OF ALL SURRENDER CHARGES. SHE LATER USED THE ISSUE THAT I FORGED HER SIGNATURE ON THE TRANSFER DOCUMENT. IT WAS LATER DETERMINED BY HER OWN HANDWRITING EXPERT, THAT ALL THE SIGNATURES WERE HER OWN.
