IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

I was engaged by {Third party} to prepare his Federal and California State S-corporation returns for his business. {Third party} set an appointment for March 17, 2016. I prepared the returns accurately and filed them electronically. They were accepted by both the Federal Government and the State of California on April 13, 2016 which deems the service provided suitable. The fact that they were filed after the March 15, 2016 deadline was because {Third party} didn't engage my services until March 17, 2016.

{Third party} then received a late filing penalty for \$195.00. He contacted me and sent me the IRS late penalty letter. My understanding was the {Third party} wanted me to seek relief so I wrote a letter on his behalf asking the IRS for abatement from the penalty I made a mistake and instead of signing my name as third Party Designee I signed {Third party's}.

As far as me not informing {Third party} of the March 15th deadline for filing S-Corporation returns I agree that even before he engaged me to do the work I should have informed him of said deadline. In my defense when March comes around and you have worked every day, twelve to fifteen hours a day, since January 4th you can drop the ball sometimes. Further, I always do courtesy extensions for clients, not knowing if they are coming back to me or not. I assumed his prior accountant would have done the same but apparently the prior accountant did not. I feel bad that {Third party} has issues with my services.
