## IAPD Information About Representatives

**Broker Statement**

In December 2014, the client invested a total of \$41,000 in this healthcare real estate income trust, a very modest portion of her total liquid assets. The client had previously invested \$50,000 in a similar real estate income trust, which we were able to liquidate at a significant profit and use some of the proceeds to make this investment. Based on her prior experience with these types of investments and further discussions we had about this particular investment, the client understood that the investment was not liquid but was intended to provide income and diversification from her other investments. While the investment initially performed well, providing the client with annual distributions of nearly 7%, unfortunately, the investment ultimately did not perform as we had expected, especially following the unforeseen Covid crisis and resulting economic turmoil that significantly impacted the market for skilled nursing home real estate. Nevertheless, the investment was absolutely suitable based on the information that was known at the time of my recommendation. Furthermore, the client has experienced an overall profit based on her initial investment of \$50,000. While it's unfortunate that the client was persuaded to join a case against LPL along with other dissatisfied investors in this healthcare real estate income trust, I am pleased that she has now decided to withdraw her claim.
