Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

THE CLIENT AGREES TO HAVING BEEN THE DECISION-MAKER ON ALL TRANSACTIONS. THE CLIENT STATES IN HIS COMPLAINT, "I DO WISH MR. JACOBSON WELL, AND GENUINELY LIKE HIM AS A PERSON."
