IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

CUSTOMERS ARE HIGH NET WORTH, KNOWLEDGEABLE INVESTORS WITH GOAL OF INCOME PRODUCING INVESTMENTS AND NEARLY TWO DECADES OF INVESTMENT EXPERIENCE. IN OUR 14 YEAR RELATIONSHIP, THE CUSTOMERS HAVE ONLY COMPLAINED ABOUT THESE TWO INVESTMENTS, WHICH ONLY RESULTED IN A 5.7% LOSS. I FULLY ADVISED THE CUSTOMERS OF THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF THE SUBJECT INVESTMENTS, WHICH THEY ACKNOWLEDGED BY SIGNING/INITIALIZING (OVER 30 TIMES) REQUIRED DISCLOSURE DOCUMENTS. THE CUSTOMERS' CLAIMS ARE WITHOUT MERIT AND ALL WRONGDOING IS DENIED. I DID NOT WANT TO SETTLE THIS MATTER AS THERE WAS NO WRONG DOING ON MY PART. HOWEVER, MY BROKER DEALER INITIATED SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS AS A BUSINESS DECISION TO AVOID THE COSTS AND UNCERTAINTIES OF PROTRACTED LITIGATION OVER A RELATIVELY SMALL SUM.
