**Allegations:** AUTHORIZED THIRD PARTY ON BEHALF OF THE PA CLIENTS CLAIMED THAT THE CLIENTS WANTED TO REPLACE THEIR VANGUARD IRAS THAT WERE INVESTED IN MARKET BASED MUTUAL FUNDS WITH A RISK-FREE FIXED INCOME INVESTMENT. THE THIRD PARTY CLAIMED THAT THE FA TOLD THE CLIENTS THAT HE COULD OFFER THEM AN IRA THAT WOULD PAY 6.0% - 6.5%. THE THIRD PARTY FURTHER CLAIMED THAT THE FA SAID HE COULD GET THE CLIENTS 6.0% INTEREST AND THAT THE INVESTMENT WOULD NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY RISK. THE CLIENTS EACH PURCHASED A GENWORTH RETIREREADY SELECTIONS VARIABLE ANNUITY (THE GENWORTH ANNUITIES) FOR THEIR IRA. THE ANNUITY CONTRACTS WERE ISSUED ON JUNE 4, 2007. THE THIRD PARTY CLAIMED THAT AFTER RECEIPT OF THEIR ANNUITY CONTRACTS, THE CLIENTS COULD NOT FIND ANY REFERENCE TO A 6.0% - 6.5% GUARANTEED RETURN; FURTHER, THAT WHEN THEIR INVESTMENTS STARTED TO DECLINE THEY CONTACTED THE FA AND WERE TOLD THAT THEIR INVESTMENTS WERE DOWN BECAUSE THE MARKETS WERE DOWN. THE THIRD PARTY CLAIMED THAT THE FA MISREPRESENTED THE PRODUCT. THE CLIENTS SEEK TO HAVE THE PROBLEM CORRECTED. NO DAMAGES OR LOSSES WERE SPECIFIED OR ANY SPECIFIC RELIEF REQUESTED. THE AGGREGATE DECLINE IN THE VALUE OF THE ANNUITIES IS ESTIMATED TO BE \$48,242.47. (6/4/07-9/22/08)
