IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

Where did this information come from?

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

I STRONGLY DENY THE ACCUSATIONS MADE BY THE CLIENTS AND THEIR COMPANY. I HAVE HAD NOTHING BUT A CLEAN TRACK RECORD AS A FINANCIAL CONSULTANT FOR 10 1/2 YEARS. THE CLIENTS STARTED A HEADHUNTING FIRM FOR TECHNOLOGY COMPANIES & INVESTED IN MANY TECHNOLOGY COMPANIES THEY DID BUSINESS WITH. THEY WERE HIGH RISK TAKERS IN THE BUSINESS & THEIR INVESTING, WHICH DID THEM WELL FOR A WHILE, BUT EVENTUALLY CAUGHT UP WITH THEM.
