IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement The FA received an email from a client to take a disbursement from their account. I emailed the client the form he needed to sign to withdraw the funds as it was his first distribution from his SEP. The signed form came back via email with the bank information filled in. The FAs had discretion on the account we didn't need to call the client to liquidate.

I worked off a list each week of clients that I needed to call to confirm upcoming disbursements. I accidentally marked my notes incorrectly and thought I had



spoken to this client when it was actually the next person in the list. We processed the distribution and a week later we received another email from the client to withdraw funds. I called the client and that's when we realized I made the mistake and didn't actually speak with him the week before. The email we received was fraud. Someone had hacked into the client's email and picked up the last email sent between the client and FA. We recalled the funds and the client was made whole. But as I marked in the system that I spoke to the client when I didn't, I was terminated.
