What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Allegations: CUSTOMER COMPLAINED TO THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE THAT HE WAS NOT AWARE THAT HE HAD SIGNED AN APPLICATION FORM ON NOVEMBER 4, 2014 TO PURCHASE A VARIABLE ANNUITY WITH FUNDS TRANSFERRED FROM HIS DECEASED WIFE'S IRA ACCOUNT. HE ALSO ALLEGED THAT THE REP HAD NEVER DELIVERED THE POLICY, NOR HAD THE CUSTOMER SIGNED THE DELIVERY RECEIPT, AND REQUESTED TO EXERCISE THE 10 DAY RIGHT-TO-CANCEL PROVISION . THE KS DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE FORWARDED THE COMPLAINT TO THE ANNUITY COMPANY.
