## IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

### What is included in a IAPD report?

- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

The client comes first. Summit should always have a back up compliance person. They did not have any one to help the client. Alliance helped me take care of the client for Summit. I NEVER did improper advertising. Summit does not like my trademark AfroEconomics because it focuses on the Black investor.

**Broker Statement**

The allegations are FALSE. This is a broker dealer that I paid to transact business NOT hold on to client accounts and slow me down because they are on vacation. The actions alleged are due to their lack of professionalism and discrimination. I did send a client application directly to the product BUT I did it to protect the client. Summit was holding the client application and transfer form because they said the compliance department manager [Third Party] was on vacation and the \$1 million dollar account was too large for the people working to process. The client was demanding that Summit NOT hold on to their business. So, the client and the product (Allianz) asked me to forward them the application to them and they explained to Summit the need to serve the client. EVENTUALLY, Summit processed the deal and they took commissions and still posted these allegations. In my opinion the client always comes first. Secondly, Of course I NEVER did improper advertising. Summit does not like my trademark brand AfroEconomics because it focuses on the Black investor. Summit Brokerage made that obvious by posting this on my U-5. I thank GOD I left that firm they do not deserve to profit off my Black clients. NEVER again. Thank you for the opportunity to share the challenges of a Black woman committed to serving her clients FIRST.
