IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

LPL COMPLIANCE WAS CONFIDENT THAT THE ACTIONS TAKEN BY MYSELF WERE CONGRUENT TO CUSTOMER STATED INSTRUCTIONS RELATIVE TO THE HANDLING OF HIS ACCOUNT. AT THAT TIME CUSTOMER & I AGREED TO CHANGE THE GTC ORDER TO A PRICE OF 23 1/2 OB TO INCREASE THE LIKELIHOOD THAT THE ORDER WOULD BE EXECUTED. CUSTOMER INCORRECTLY ASSERTED THAT THE BANK OR LPL WAS LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE TO HOLD HIS ISB CORP. CERTIFICATES AND FELT WE OWED HIM THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN \$27.5 AND \$23.5 ON 3,000 SHARES.
