What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Broker Statement	Norwood Economics was not the plan advisor until the fall of 2016. The Cash Balance plan design was created in 2015 by another Advisor. The contribution amounts were determined as part of the plan design prior to Norwood Economics taking over as plan advisor. The IRS requires 3 years of consistent contributions prior to any plan design changes. The earliest opportunity to change the contribution amounts was for plan year 2018. The client elected to make no changes and contribution amounts remained stable through 2021. The plan



advisor has no input on contribution amounts, regardless. The actuarial firm hired as the TPA makes actuarial calculations to determine Plan contribution amounts. Norwood Economics was hired to manage the Cash Balance Plan account and had no input into plan contribution amounts.
