In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

It's very disappointing to me that this arbitration claim and award appears on my record, as I always acted properly and in the best interests of my client, as I have done for all my clients throughout my almost 27 years now as a financial advisor. These clients brought claims against my employer, not against me, alleging that the firm's written disclosure materials misrepresented an options overlay strategy they participated in. It is reported on my record solely because FINRA rules require the reporting of arbitration claims on the record of the claimant's broker of record. I was not a named party to the action, there was no award against me, I was not asked to contribute in any way to the award, and I have not been the subject of any disciplinary action by my employer or any regulator. In fact, after the panel rendered its decision against my firm, the clients' own attorney - the one who won the case against my employer wrote: "I hardly ever feel this way, but I'm sorry that the arbitrators didn't agree to expungement of the claims from Jason's record. He's a good guy . . . My clients believe and testified that Mr. Dworak has a lot of integrity, and they are still doing business with him."
