What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Allegations: Claimants and owners of K&C Realty allege that in 2008, their advisor recommended they make an unsuitable 1031 Exchange with the proceeds of the sale of a building and reinvest the sale proceeds in three TIC investments in order to defer capital gains. Claimants allege that one of the three TIC's recommended was unsuitable and that they did not know that it was a TIC investment until in 2017, when the distributions were suspended. Claimants seek rescission of the TIC and recovery of the full investment.
