IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Allegations: CLIENT'S ATTORNEY STATES CLIENT INFORMED IR THAT HE COULD NOT AFFORD TO LOSE ANY OF HIS PRINCIPAL BECAUSE THE FUNDS CONSTITUTED ALL OF THE MONEY CLIENT HAD. ATTORNEY STATES IR ASSURED CLIENT IR WOULD INVEST THE MONEY ACCORDINGLY AND THAT CLIENT WOULD MAKE MONEY ON THE INVESTMENTS. ATTORNEY INDICATES CLIENT REAPEATEDLY CONTACTED IR REGARDING THE DECLINE IN ACCOUNT VALUE AND QUESTIONED WHETHER THE FUNDS SHOULD BE MOVED TO STOP ANY FURTHER DECLINE. ATTORNEY CLAIMS CLIENT RELIED ON IR'S ADVICE TO MAINTAIN THE INVESTMENTS. ATTORNEY STATES THAT IN EARLY 2003, CLIENT HAD IR MOVE THE FUNDS TO A MONEY MARKET ACCOUNT WHERE CLIENT WOULD NO LONGER LOSE VALUE. ATTORNEY INDICATES THE SECURITIES PURCHASED WERE UNSUITABLE FOR CLIENT'S AGE AND FINANCIAL SITUATION AND THAT THE IR FAILED TO PROPERLY MONITOR THE ACCOUNT. ATTORNEY CLAIMS TOTAL DAMAGES ARE AT LEAST \$45,000 AND IS DEMANDING CLIENT BE COMPENSATED FOR HIS LOSSES.

Broker Statement

ACCORDING TO IR, CLIENT TRANSFERRED HIS IRA IN NOVEMBER 1999. (IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING CLIENT OPENED HIS ACCOUNT WITH AMERICAN FUNDS IN 1996.) IR STATED CLIENT WAS INTERESTED IN GROWTH OF PRINCIPAL AND CLIENT ALSO DESIRED TO TAKE A MONTHLY INCOME. IR INDICATED CLIENT HAD ALL HIS ASSETS IN THE WASHINGTON MUTUAL INVESTORS FUND AND IR RECOMMENDED CLIENT DIVERSIFY INTO TWO ADDITIONAL MUTUAL FUNDS. IR STATED HE DISCUSSED THE RISKS WITH EACH FUND AND IR MADE NO GUARANTEES AS TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THE MUTUAL FUND. IR INDICATED HE ALSO EXPLAINED TO CLIENT THAT IT WOULD BE VERY DIFFICULT FOR CLIENT'S MONEY TO GROW WHILE TAKING AN INCOME OF OVER 7.5% PER YEAR. IR FURTHER STATED HE DISCUSSED THE ACCOUNT WITH CLIENT ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS DURING 2000-2003. IR ENCOURAGED CLIENT TO REDUCE THE INCOME TAKEN FROM THE MUTUAL FUNDS; HOWEVER, CLIENT INFORMED IR HE COULD NOT REDUCE THE INCOME. IR STATED THE PROS AND CONS OF ALTERNATIVE INVESTMENTS WERE ALSO DISCUSSED AND EACH TIME CLIENT MADE THE DECISION TO HOLD OFF MAKING CHANGES. OUR RECORDS REFLECT THAT IN FEBRUARY 2003, THE MUTUAL FUNDS WERE EXCHANGED INTO THE AMERICAN FUNDS MONEY MARKET. GIVEN THE CONVERSATIONS BETWEEN IR AND CLIENT REGARDING THE INVESTMENT OBJECTIVES FOR THESE ASSETS, IT DOES NOT APPEAR THE INVESTMENTS WERE OUTSIDE THE STATED OBJECTIVES OF THE ACCOUNT. ALTHOUGH WE UNDERSTAND CLIENT'S DISAPPOINTMENT WITH THE DECLINE IN VALUE OF THE MUTUAL FUNDS, IT DOES APPEAR THE LOSS IS PRIMARILY DUE TO WITHDRAWALS BY CLIENT (APPROX \$122,323 SINCE NOVEMBER 1999). BASED ON OUR REVIEW, THE FIRM RESPECTFULLY DENIES THE REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF DAMAGES (I.E. LOSSES, LOST INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES, ATTORNEY FEES, ETC.). CLAIM DENIED.
