IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Allegations: CLIENT STATES HE AUTHORIZED THE IR TO SELL 1,152 SHARES OF INTEL IN HIS ACCOUNT IN JANUARY 2005. CLIENT ALLEGES THE IR SOLD A TOTAL OF 1,577 SHARES WITHOUT HIS AUTHORIZATION. THE PROCEEDS WERE UTILIZED TO PURCHASE SHARES OF APPLIED MATERIALS INC AND CISCO SYSTEMS INC. THE CLIENT REQUESTS ALL TRANSACTIONS BE REVERSED OR, AT THE VERY LEAST, 424 SHARES OF INTEL SHOULD BE REINSTATED IN THE ACCOUNT. COST TO CANCEL TRADES WOULD EXCEED \$5,000.00.

ACCORDING TO THE IR, IT IS HIS UNDERSTANDING THE CLIENT'S INTENT WAS TO "BE AGGRESSIVE" WITH THE ACCOUNT. IN ADDITION, THE CLIENT HAS RECEIVED STATEMENTS THAT PROVIDE INFORMATION REGARDING THE INVESTMENTS HELD IN THE ACCOUNT AS WELL AS REFLECTING ACCOUNT ACTIVITY. BASED ON OUR REVIEW, IT IS OUR OPINION THE TRANSACTIONS EFFECTED IN THE ACCOUNT WERE COMPLETED WITH THE CLIENT'S KNOWLEDGE AND AUTHORIZATION. FURTHERMORE, THE COMMISSIONS ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRANSACTIONS APPEAR TO BE APPROPRIATE BASED ON FIRM GUIDELINES. CLAIM DENIED.
