CLIENT ALLEGES THAT THEIR REGISTERED REPRESENTATIVE, FRANKLIN C. TILLER, JR., DID NOT INFORM THEM OF THE NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES THAT MAY BE ASSOCIATED WITH HOLDING A SINGLE STOCK POSITION THAT CLIENT TRANSFERRED TO THE FIRM FROM THE CLIENTS' FORMER FINANCIAL ADVISOR. THEIR CLAIM IS THAT THIS FAILURE TO DIVERSIFY THEIR PRE-EXISTING PORTFOLIO CAUSED LOSSES IN THEIR ACCOUNT. CLIENT OWNED A TELECOMMUNICATIONS FIRM THAT WAS SOLD TO A PUBLICLY TRADED CORPORATION. THE SALE WAS STRUCTURED AS A STOCK TRANSACTION AND THE CLIENT WAS TO RECEIVE 203,639 SHARES OF RCNC STOCK VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$27 PER SHARE. CLIENT WAS REFERRED TO MR. TILLER BY THE FIRM'S WASHINGTON DC OFFICE AND AN ACCOUNT WAS OPENED AUGUST 2000. MR. TILLER EXPLAINED AND PRESENTED THE BENEFITS OF DIVERSIFICATION AND SUGGESTED HEDGING STRATEGIES. THE CLIENT WAS OPPOSED TO ANY SUCH STRATEGY BECAUSE HE BELIEVED THAT THE STOCK PRICE WOULD DRAMATICALLY INCREASE AND WAS WILLING TO TAKE THE RISK AND RIDE OUT THE MARKET. INDEED, THE CLIENT PROVIDED INFORMATION FROM CERTAIN NON-JPMSI WALL STREET ANALYSTS THE CLIENT FOLLOWED TARGETING THE STOCK AT A SUBSTANTIALLY HIGHER PRICE. WHEN THE STOCK PRICE CONTINUED TO DECLINE, CLIENT ALLEGED THAT HE WAS NOT INFORMED OF THE DIVERSIFICATION STRATEGIES. THE FIRM HAS INVESTIGATED THIS MATTER AND BELIEVES THAT THE CLAIM AGAINST TILLER AND THE FIRM IS WITHOUT MERIT AND IS IN THE PROCESS OF RESPONDING TO AND DENYING THE ALLEGATIONS.
