IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

### What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

### Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

**Allegations:** CLIENT STATES SHE IS VERY DISAPPOINTED IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE VARIABLE LIFE POLICY THAT WAS PURCHASED IN APRIL 2001. CLIENT STATES SHE HAS PAID \$12,200 INTO THE POLICY AND THE CASH VALUE IS \$4,864. CLIENT INDICATES RHODES DID NOT DISCLOSE THE FREE LOOK PERIOD AND THE NINE-YEAR MINIMUM SURRENDER TERM. CLIENT STATES RHODES RAN ILLUSTRATIONS WITH A 12% RETURN. CLIENT ALSO STATES SHE SOLD AND MOVED MOST OF HER INVESTMENTS FROM EDWARD JONES IN OCTOBER 2002 AT A LOSS OF ALMOST \$46,000. LOSSES EXCEED \$5,000.

IR INDICATED HE PROVIDED SEVERAL GENERIC HYPOTHETICALS TO CLIENT, INCLUDING AN EXAMPLE WITH WITHDRAWALS AND COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ANNUITY PRODUCT. IR STATED THE EXAMPLES REFLECTED THE VALUE AND RISKS OF THE VARIABLE LIFE POLICY, AND FURTHER STATED THAT HE REVIEWED ALL EXPENSES, SURRENDER CHARGES AND RISKS. DURING THIS DISCUSSION, IR INDICATED CLIENT HAD STATED NINE YEARS WAS A LONG SURRENDER PERIOD. IR INFORMED CLIENT THAT TO MAKE A VARIABLE LIFE POLICY WORK, THE FUNDING TAKES YEARS AND THE IR DID NOT BELIEVE THE SURRENDER PERIOD WAS TOO LONG ON THIS TYPE OF PRODUCT. IR ALSO STATED THAT HE PROVIDED AT LEAST TWENTY ILLUSTRATIONS TO CLIENT REPRESENTING DIFFERENT SCENARIOS. ACCORDING TO IR, CLIENT CAME INTO HIS OFFICE TO COMPLETE THE APPLICATIONS AND AT THAT TIME IR REVIEWED THE ILLUSTRATIONS, AS WELL AS DISCLOSING THE FREE LOOK OPTION, SURRENDER FEES, VARIABLE PERFORMANCE AND THE EXPECTED ANNUAL PREMIUMS. IR INDICATED ALL HYPOTHETICALS WERE RUN AT 10% AND THIS IS REFLECTED ON THE ILLUSTRATIONS SIGNED BY CLIENT IN APRIL 2001. IR STATED HE SPOKE WITH CLIENT AFTER THE POLICY WAS ESTABLISHED AND EXPRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF CONTINUING TO PAY THE PREMIUMS. WHILE THE FIRM UNDERSTANDS THE CLIENT'S DISAPPOINTMENT IN THE DECLINE OF THE ACCOUNT VALUE, IT APPEARS THE DECLINE IS A RESULT OF MARKET FLUCTUATION, WHICH IS ONE OF THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH OWNING ANY INVESTMENT. IN ADDITION, IR STATED MANY LOSSES WERE THE RESULT OF SELL INSTRUCTIONS FROM CLIENT, WHILE IR CONTINUED TO ADVISE CLIENT TO HOLD. IR INDICATED CLIENT DESIRED A QUICK RETURN ON HER INVESTMENTS; HOWEVER, THE FIRM'S INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY IS TO BUY QUALITY INVESTMENTS AND HOLD FOR THE LONG TERM. CLIENT RECEIVED PROSPECTUSES ON THE APPLICABLE INVESTMENTS AND IT IS THE FIRM'S OPINION THAT THE CLIENT WAS AWARE OF THE ACTIVITY IN THE ACCOUNT AND ALL TRANSACTIONS WERE COMPLETED WITH HER AUTHORIZATION. THEREFORE, THE FIRM WILL NOT BE MAKING ANY ADJUSTMENTS TO CLIENT'S ACCOUNTS OR LINKED ACCOUNTS.
