What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

The client claims that he accepted an employment offer with the expectation that he would continue participation in the NJ ABP, declined a secondary employment offer and has sustained an economic loss of \$142,866 due to the forfeiture of benefits under the State's plan.

Broker Statement

The client requested to have his TIAA contracts consolidated into his current employer plan in August 2017. More than 2 weeks after he returned the forms, he was notified via email and a phone call, that his rollover request could not be processed because he needed to complete the one page form from the State of New Jersey titled New Jersey Alternate Benefit Program Withdrawal Request Acknowledgement Receipt form. That form explicitly disclosed to the client the consequences of a rollover from the Alternate Benefit Program on an individual's ability to enroll in a New Jersey State-administered retirement system in the future. In fact, it was designed by the New Jersey Division of Pension and Benefits for that very purpose. The single page form, sent to him separately, clearly states in bold face type,

"Participation in the Alternate Benefit Program shall terminate and the individual shall be considered retired once he or she has elected to receive a cash distribution of the value of his or her accounts in a direct payout as a cash distribution, a rollover, or an annuity (or a combination of these distributions). The member is considered retired and is not eligible to enroll in any New Jersey State-administered retirement system, nor are they eligible to reenroll in or receive any other benefits afforded under the Alternate Benefit Program.[1]

The onset of the form states the importance of reading the form before signing by stating "It is important that you read and understand the contents prior to making any decisions regarding elections to withdraw 401(a) contributions." The client signed the single page form acknowledging that he understood the ramification of rolling over his accounts from his Mandatory 401a NJABP plans.
