What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement	This complaint was really a misunderstanding on the part of the client and not any wrongdoing on my behalf. The client's previous managed account program was discontinued by the firm as a result of changes in industry regulations. The new managed program selected by the client differed in the fee structure from the previous program and billed on cumulative trading activity rather than based on the value of the assets in the account. The new fee structure was explained to the client and the client was advised of the changes in writing as well. However, once on the new platform, the client increased their trading activity significantly and their fees increased accordingly. This complaint had no merit and was settled at a fraction of the amount claimed, as a business decision by the firm.
