### Where did this information come from?

#### Broker Statement

In March 2017, I hired a general contractor to remodel my kitchen, master, and guest bathroom. The work consisted of removing two load bearing walls, rerouting plumbing, making electrical modifications and installing new cabinetry. After leaving the project incomplete for 8 months he submitted a bill which was 38% more than the high end of the agreed upon price. I questioned him about the noises coming from the beams he recently installed and he claimed that there was nothing wrong with the installation. He stated that I could get an engineer to inspect at my expense if I thought otherwise.

I hired a Licensed Structural Engineer to examine the load bearing beams. The Engineers report detailed the new beams were 40% undersized for the load they were carrying, installed upside down with incorrect and an insufficient number of fasteners, improperly supported and without permits. The Engineer stated "It was not a matter of IF they would fail but When and ON Whom." Consequently, my house no longer passes a structural inspection.

It was then that I hired a Licensed Master Plumber and Licensed Master Electrician to inspect the remaining work. Their reports detailed numerous electrical and plumbing code violations in addition to no permits. At this point all



the experts agreed these repairs would have to be made in order for the house to pass a structural, electrical or plumbing inspection and more importantly to place the home in a safe living condition. Unfortunately in order to fix the construction defects and/or to repair the code violations it meant having to take these areas back down to the bare studs and starting the remodel from scratch based on the code violations found during the inspections.

Multiple estimates received to repair the defects and code violations were approximately \$86,000. At this point I refused to pay the contractors invoice and he sued me in court.

It was discovered prior to trial that I was billed several thousand dollars for materials that were used for other projects the contractor was working on at the same time. I lost the case because the jury felt I should've paid the contractor first and then had him come back to fix the defective work which would have resulted in a complete remodel.

During the corrective phase currently taking place, additional defective work and code violations have been discovered which has added several thousand dollars in repair costs bringing the total to over \$90,000.
